

Bruce Farm in Burrell Township holds Dedication

Dr. and Mrs. Edgar Bruce of Burrell Township were honored on July 20, 2009 with a Farmland Preservation Sign and Dedication Ceremony. The event was attended by the Armstrong County Board of Commissioners, representatives from Senator Don White and Representative Jeff Pyle's offices, members of the Armstrong Conservation District, the bicentennial and Century Farm Program, the Farm Service Agency and County Land Preservation Program Officials and Board Members.

The farm officially known as Woak-Hanne Farm, the Delaware Indian word for Crooked Creek, is the first county farm to be permanently protected from development through this program. The County Plans to award more farms preservation, including the Patterson's farm in Kiskiminetas Township.
