

Polling Place Changes / 911 Update

The Voter Registration Department has been working with all of the new technology that is available to them and has finalized the addressing system used to determine which polling place voters should be voting in.

As the new data is put into the system, new ID cards will be generated for those individuals who have been changed from one polling place to another. Therefore, over the next few months, if you receive a new voter ID card pay special attention to the polling place information because it has been changed.

There may be some cases where an individual has voted at the same place since they registered to vote, however, because we can actually pinpoint the location of each address it is apparent that you have been voting in the wrong place and it has been changed.
