

Kittanning Township County Aid Project

The Armstrong County Commissioners met today with Kittanning Township officials to view recently completed road and bridge projects in the Township. The projects included the replacement of the guide rail on Baker Bridge located on Baker Road (T-646), as well as the replacement of the guide rail on Township Bridge #5 located on Graham Road (T-565). The total project cost was \$10,300 with \$9550 being provided by the Armstrong County Commissioners through the County Liquid Fuels program. Kittanning Township was one of eight municipalities to share the nearly \$100,000 worth of funding awarded through the County Liquid Fuels program earlier this year. Later this year, the County Commissioners will determine if they will be able to offer the program again in 2010.
