At the October 15, 2009 Public Meeting the Armstrong County Board of Commissioners proclaimed October 19, 2009 as Armstrong County Community Awareness Day. This year's theme is "respect"; everyone is asked to make decisions and responses that are in a respectful manner to themselves, others and the community.

This is the 6th Annual Community Awareness Day, an event that began in January 2004 through the collaborative efforts of District Attorney Scott Andreassi, Magisterial District Judge J. Gary DeComo and Sheriff Larry Crawford. The goal was to raise the level of prevention and awareness to combat the social ills and crimes of the abuse of alcohol and other drugs, child abuse, elder abuse, sexual assault and domestic violence.

District Justice DeComo announced that there will be an event on October 19, 2009 at Lenape Technical School from 4:00 to 7:30 PM.
