At today's Public Meeting the Armstrong County Board of Commissioners adopted a Proclamation to honor Magisterial District Judge J. Gary DeComo and the tenth anniversary of his Drugs Kill Dreams campaign. The drug prevention program was originally established in 1994, but was renamed in 2000 following a fourth grade poster contest sponsored by the Manor Township Lions' Club.

The Commissioners have declared April 26th through the 30th as Drugs Kill Dreams Week in Armstrong County.
