Fiscal Year 2008/09 Facts & Statistics:

- **Staffing: 42 (full & part-time) staff positions with over 414 combined years of experience and dedication in serving the older adults at the Armstrong County Area Agency on Aging, (average 9.6 years of service per employee.)**
- **250 Volunteers donated 26,285 hours in agency programs.**
- **Agency offered over 28 Services & Programs for older adults.**
- **Received 4,417 calls for information and referral.**
- **Over 7,830 persons received one or more Agency Services.**
- **Operated 10 Senior Community Centers and 2 Satellite Centers throughout Armstrong County.**
- **Provided 62,115 Congregate Meals and 91,897 Home Delivered Meals.**
- **Provided over 6,245 social/recreational/educational/health activities.**
- **Aging Care Management Staff completed 2,382 in-home assessments and re-assessments for program eligibility determination.**
- **Received 78 Protective Services Reports, 70 cases of which 32 were substantiated.**
- **Provided Health Insurance Counseling through the APPRISE Program to 225 older adults.**
- **Ombudsman Staff/trained volunteers completed 82 resident visits in facilities in Armstrong County.**
- **Sponsored 26,658 Center and Medical Transportation Trips.**
- **Provided over 27,408 hours of In-Home Services to eligible persons within Armstrong County.**
