The Armstrong County Commissioners announced a total of \$156,551 of grant funding awards for municipal roadway restoration projects. The following municipalities will be receiving County Aid funding:

- Apollo Borough - \$8,100 for Crosswalk Safety Improvements
- Bethel Township - \$9,190 for Grantz Hollow Road Culvert Replacements
- Brady's Bend Township - \$15,000 for Philips Street Road Improvements
- Elderton Borough - \$2,690 for Paving of South 3rd Alley
- Freeport Borough - \$15,000 for Paving of Main Street and Old Pike Road
- Kiskiminetas Township - \$15,000 for Paving of Deewood Manor, Laurel Way and Locust Street
- Kittanning Township - \$11,091 for the Graham Road Guiderail Project
- Mahoning Township - \$2,495 for the Kohlersburg Road Culvert Replacement
- Manorville Borough - \$15,000 for Paving of Center Lane
- Plumcreek Township - \$5,000 for Pipe Replacement on Village Road
- Redbank Township - \$12,985 for Oil and Chipping of Crossroads Road
- Sugarcreek Township - \$15,000 for the Beagle Club Road Underdrain Project
- West Kittanning Borough - \$15,000 for the Nixon Avenue Road Improvement Project
- Worthington Borough - \$15,000 for Paving of Pine, South Cherry and Maple Street and Long's Circle

Since the inception of the program, the County has awarded \$953,397 for projects in thirty-eight municipalities in Armstrong County.
