REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG OBO MANOR TOWNSHIP

School Street Reconstruction Project

The County of Armstrong on behalf of Manor Township proposes to utilize part of their FFY 2015 Community Development Block Grant for the reconstruction of School Street.

The proposed scope for the School Street Reconstruction Project shall consist of 4" milling of 600 SY, 60 SY of 19 MM binder base repairs, 70 tons of 9.5 MM fine wearing scratch course, 600 SY paving fabric, 85 tons of 199 MM binder (2.5" depth); 600 SY of 9.5 MM wearing course (1.5" depth), maintenance and protection of traffic, engineering design, construction inspection, associated restoration and related appurtenances.

In awarding a contract to complete engineering, design and inspection relating to the reconstruction of the street known as School Street, the County of Armstrong and Manor Township will consider the completeness of the proposal; technical qualifications; previous experience on similar projects; the ability to complete the work within a designated time frame; and the utilization of Section 3 contractors, subcontractors, businesses, and residents. Primary criterion, therefore, in selecting an offeror will be professional qualifications. Award of a contract will be made to the proposer determined to be most technically qualified subject to negotiations of a fair and reasonable compensation for the services provided.

Proposal documents may be obtained at the offices of the Armstrong County Department of Planning and Development, 402 Market Street, Kittanning, PA 16201 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday, where completed proposals will be received until 4:00 P.M., Monday, November 21, 2016.

The County of Armstrong and/or Manor Township reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to waive any informalities in the proposal process and may hold all proposals for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of proposal submission deadline.
