## Vision for the Future

Market Street, which is Kittanning Borough’s commercial/business center and the heart of the community has started its transformation. Phase I of the Market Street Revitalization Project in the 300 block of Market Street is complete. Phase I was completed utilizing the Borough’s Community Development Block Grant funds, Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program funds, and local donations.

Phase II of the construction, which will complete the remainder of Market Street has begun. This phase will be completed utilizing a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant provided to the Borough by the Department of Transportation and local donations. We have been given a great opportunity to make this change for our Community.

The Market Street Revitalization Committee along with Kittanning Borough officials are seeking the remaining \$200,000 in matching funds in order to meet the grant requirements for the Multimodal Transportation funds that are being used for the construction of Phase II.

**A Summary of Phase II Improvements:**

- Elimination of overhead utility wires
- Decorative historic style Street Lights with under-ground service
- Sidewalks with decorative brick paving
- Handicap ramps per Americans with Disabilities Standards
- Street trees and furnishings
- Landscaped sidewalk bumpouts
- Curb-side parking with decorative historic style meters
- Underground conduits for electric telephone, cable and internet service
- Street resurfacing, striping and signage
- Two-way traffic on Jefferson Street between Jacob and Arch Street
