

- VISITING RULES

- Weapons, cell phones, cameras or contraband of any type are prohibited in this facility.
- All visitors must sign in at Central Control and show a valid form of photo ID and sign out upon completion of visit.
- All visitors must be 18 years of age. No one under 18 years of age is permitted on jail property without prior approval of the Warden.
- All visitors are responsible for their actions.
- Visits will be conducted on a first come, first serve basis and will be limited to 20 minutes.
- Smoking and tobacco use in the lobby and visiting areas is prohibited.
- All visitors will wait in the parking lot until their scheduled visit time.
- All visitors are subject to search at any time while in the facility.
- Vehicles must be secure at all times and may be searched.
- Any visitor suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance will be turned away.
- All visitors must be dressed appropriately for a family setting.
- Only the items necessary to conduct the visit may be brought into the visiting area. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED.
- All notes, letters, cards, etc. must be sent through the U.S. Postal Service.
- No more than one adult is permitted to visit an inmate at one time and may only visit one inmate per session.
- Former inmates are not permitted to visit unless it has been 30 days since their release.
- Any visitor who is unruly or uses profane language or gestures of any type will be asked to leave and their visiting privileges will be revoked.
- Only approved visitors on the inmates visitor list will be permitted to visit. All others will be turned away.

- Armstrong County Jail will in no way be held responsible for items lost, damaged, or stolen during your visit. All items not specifically needed for the visit should remain secured in your vehicle or in one of the lockers provided.
- Co-Defendants are NOT allowed to visit.
- Inmates are only permitted one visit per week at this time, to allow all inmates to receive visits with the limited seating
- Please keep in mind others safety, social distancing with 6 feet apart
- This facility follows the Governor's Orders of wearing masks properly unless approved otherwise from administration for health reasons
