ARMSTRONG COUNTY ANNEX BUILDING REOPENING

Kittanning, PA – Armstrong County Courthouse Annex building will open Monday, May 18, 2020 in response to moving to phase “yellow”.

Armstrong County has been diligent in their work to clean and sanitize the public areas for the upcoming opening. Areas where employees and the public interact have been fitted with Plexiglas shields and signage has been posted to remind everyone who enters the building to practice social distancing.

Only 10 people will be allowed to enter the building at any given time with the occupancy being enforced by a County Deputy Sherriff.

Upon entering the building, everyone will be screened by a County Deputy Sherriff which will include a round of health questions concerning COVID-19 symptoms. Anyone presenting symptoms or who does not have a facemask will be denied entry into the building.

Phone or email contact to any of the departments in the Courthouse, Courthouse Annex building or other County owned or operated buildings is still highly encouraged. Other County owned buildings will be open to the public by appointment only starting Monday as well.

As of today, the PA DOH is reporting 55 positive cases in Armstrong County and 5 fatalities.

Using the metric set forth by Governor Wolfe, Armstrong County’s case rate is currently at 7.69. Armstrong County has continued to trend down in the number of positive cases and has had no new reported cases in the last six days. Southwestern Pennsylvania has a total reported case rate of 18.23.
