## **ARMSTRONG COUNTY WORKING TO VACCINATE PHASE 1A POPULATION**

Kittanning, PA – Armstrong County is in the process of working to vaccinate Phase 1A population. The County health care providers are following the PA Department of Health “phased” roll out of the vaccine distribution.

With initial supplies limited, the COVID-19 vaccine will be distributed to Pennsylvanians in four phases. Pennsylvania is currently in Phase 1A and the County has begun vaccinating those most at-risk of illness, such as health care workers and Pennsylvanians living in long-term care facilities, persons age 65 and older, and those age 16-64 with high-risk conditions.

Currently, those interested can sign up for the vaccine through ACMH hospital and through Klingensmith’s health care. Also, please check with your PCP or health care provider for vaccination information.

### **Most current information from ACMH as of 2-02-2021:**

**ACMH Hospital has currently suspended scheduling of new COVID-19 vaccinations for the public due to the extremely low amount and inconsistent delivery of vaccine being provided by the PA Department of Health to their facility.**
